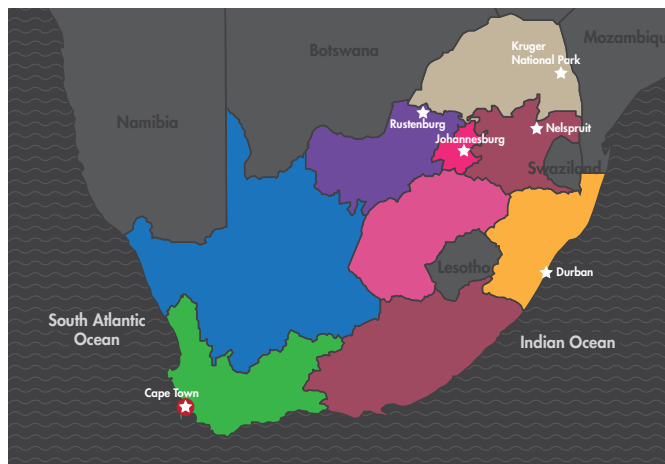
SOUTH AFRICA

FAST FACTS

Passport & Visa - Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of departure from South Africa. A 90 day permit will be issued on arrival to citizens of the Commonwealth (including Australia).

Electricity - The electricity supply is 220/230 volts AC 50 HZ. Most plugs have 2 or 3-pin but you'll need to buy an adapter.

Time - South Africa is GMT +2 (or 10 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time)

Telephone - Country code 27; international access 09

Money - Rand - AU\$1 = R6.8. ATM's can be found in most cities and towns.

Seasons - South Africa's climate is generally sunny and pleasant, but there is considerable regional variation: the northwest is very arid, the south is temperate, and the northeast has a more typically tropical climate. Winters (May to August) are generally mild, particularly in the Western Cape.

Health - Malaria can be found in parts of South Africa. Please check with your health professional prior to travelling.

Capital - Pretoria (administrative), Bloemfontein (judicial) and Cape Town (legislative)

Languages - South Africa has 11 official languages including English and plenty of unofficial ones.

Water - South Africa's tap water amongst the safest and cleanest in the world.

Population - 46.9 million

DURBAN

FRIDAY 11 JUNE - TUESDAY 15 JUNE, 2010

Durban is South Africa's second largest city thanks largely to its strategic importance and value as a harbour – it is the largest and busiest port on the African continent. Durban is also called eThekweni which is a Zulu word meaning Place of the Bay. The city's cultural mix is fascinating with its large Indian population and predominant Zulu tribe mixed with a strong colonial legacy. It is a major commercial and industrial city and the surrounding area's primary industry is sugar cane farming and processing. The climate is tropical, ocean very warm and with its year round balmy weather it makes a perfect holiday paradise.



Day 1: Arrival in South Africa – Friday 11 June, 2010

Arrive in Johannesburg but not for long, just time to transfer to another flight to Durban. On arrival at Durban airport you will be met by a local English speaking guide and transferred to 3 star Coastlands Hotel. There will be time to check-in and freshen up before the Welcome Dinner. (d)

Day 2: Day at Leisure – Saturday 12 June, 2010

After a scrumptious breakfast in the comfort of your hotel, learn more about your destination country in a fascinating orientation session. Then enjoy the day at your leisure.

Day 3: Game Day – Sunday 13 June, 2010

JOHANNESBURG

WEDNESDAY 16 JUNE - SATURDAY 19 JUNE, 2010

Johannesburg is currently the largest city in Southern Africa with more than six million people and urbanisation at 97%. It is a city of contrasts with wealthy suburbs and commercial centres alongside informal settlements, Indian bazaars and African muti (medicine) shops, where traditional healers dispense advice and traditional medicine. Johannesburg is in Gauteng Province. "Gauteng" is a Sotho word meaning Place of Gold. It is the smallest of the South Africa's nine provinces, but is the centre for commercial business and governance. South Africa's wealth is based primarily in the Golden Reef that makes up the Witwatersrand (Ridge of White Waters), of which Johannesburg is the centre. The city's history dates back to 1886, when gold was discovered in this area.



Day 6: Johannesburg – Wednesday 16 June, 2010

Enjoy breakfast at The Coastlands Hotel for the final time before checking out. After check-out transfer to Durban International Airport for a flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival, check in to the stunning four star Life Hotel-the Palms and then spend the afternoon taking in the sights and sounds of the hotel surroundings.

The Palms is situated in the beautiful valley of Equestria in the east of Pretoria. In close proximity to all amenities, shopping malls, restaurants it is ideally positioned. The hotel is surrounded by over 100 palm trees, huge old trees, lush green gardens and breathtaking water features. A really beautiful sanctuary combining a stunning balance between old and new.

Day 7: Day at Leisure – Thursday 17 June, 2010

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before a day of leisure. 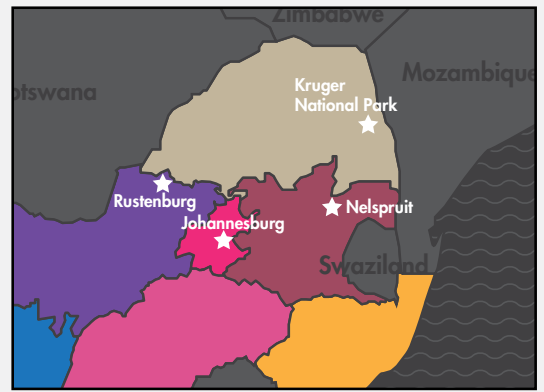
Day 9: Game Day – Saturday 19 June, 2010

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

SUNDAY 20 JUNE - WEDNESDAY 23 JUNE, 2010

The Kruger National Park was founded by the government in 1926. Today, Kruger National Park encompasses nearly 12,000 square miles (larger than Israel) of wildlife safari country and supports more than 800 species of animals living in their natural habitats. The park, rich in biodiversity, stretches for 350 kms from south to north along the Mozambican border before meeting up with the Zimbabwean border in the north. This is a paradise for the wildlife enthusiast and is a world leader in dynamic environmental management techniques and policies based on experience gained over more than a century.



Day 10: Transfer to Kruger – Sunday 20 June, 2010

Enjoy breakfast at the Signature Life Hotel for the final time before checking out. After check-out the group will transfer by coach to Kruger National Park.

Accommodation for the next 4 nights will be the 3 star Pine Lake Inn, which is situated amidst the splendour of the Mpumalanga woodlands and overlooking a tranquil lake. The Kingfisher Restaurant offers a vast choice from a la carte or delicious buffet and the Feathers Bar - a fun place to meet for a sundowner or nightcap. Each room is furnished with private bathroom, radio, telephone, colour TV with M-Net, individually controlled air-conditioning and electric shaver plug. Tonight enjoy dinner at the hotel. (b,d)

As an exciting optional activity, transfer to Nelspruit to see Italy vs. New Zealand.
